Methodology

Methodology: 15-minute online survey

Markets: US and Germany

Fieldwork:

- 2022 Wave 1: May 2022
- 2024 Wave 2: March 2024

Sample definition and size:

Nationally representative samples of the general population in terms of age (18+), gender, and location in the US and Germany

- Total base size in 2022: n=4,003 respondents (n=2,002 in the US and n=2,001 in Germany)
- Total base size in 2024: n=4,000 respondents (n=2,000 in the US and n=2,000 in Germany)

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
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The state of the German-American partnership today

The German-American partnership




Clear drop in optimism around the partnership across countries and generations. More are ambivalent too




Trade, common interests and military alliance remain the partnership's main characteristics

Germans feel more negatively towards the partnership, whilst Americans become more ambivalent





Germany/America as a country






Social inequality and rise of extremism are the main drivers of division in the US, according to the Germans

Business is the most trusted across countries. Americans remain more trusting of German institutions


% of trust in institutions of each other's country







Most still think the partnership remains strong and has a key role to play in achieving global stability





Americans and Germans share a wide range of concerns, including cost of living, conflicts, and lack of consensus





Q22: In your opinion, what should be the top 3 priorities of the transatlantic partnership between the US and Germany?






Top 5 priorities for <u>business</u> **on both countries** % who agree that German and American businesses...






More transparency and collaboration on defense & economic security would drive trust in governments further

Executive Summary

1 Trust in the German-American partnership has declined since 2022

- 2 Business is the most trusted institution in both countries and must play a key role in the partnership
- 3 High expectations of the German-American partnership

- Decline in trust in the partnership is **more evident in Germany**, with people being more skeptical and worried about the partnership.
- Optimism observed two years ago is waning with fewer believing the best days of the partnership are ahead and a large proportion of the population, particularly in the US, not being able to form an opinion.
- A growing **lack of willingness to reach compromise and consensus** has dented trust in the other country, as have increased extremism and misinformation.
- Businesses on both sides share common strengths in their competence, reliability, quality, and innovation.
- Both Germans and Americans expect an association between governments and businesses to drive the partnership going forward.
- The partnership remains strong and plays a crucial role in the world's stability.
- People on both sides **share concerns** about the rising cost of living, wars and conflicts, and lack of willingness to reach a consensus.
- The efforts of the partnership to contain Russian aggression are acknowledged, but **people also expect the partnership to deliver more** on climate change, economic growth, and human rights, in order to be relevant to them personally.
- **Clear actions**, especially around transparency, are expected from businesses and governments on both sides to further drive trust.
